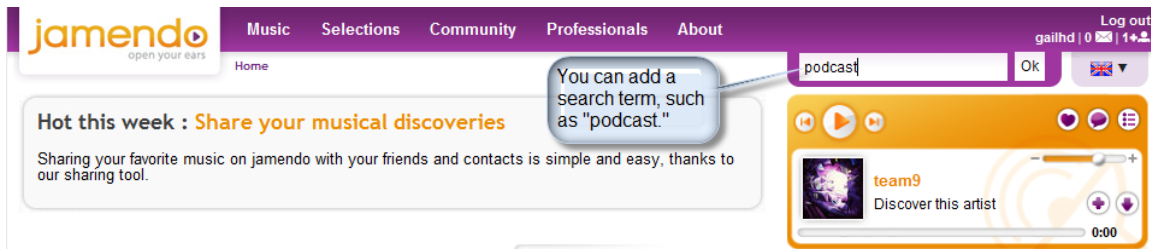


Downloading Freely Licensed, Podcast Safe Music from Jamendo

**With much appreciation to all Jamendo musicians!*

1. It's always a good idea before you start any project to create a folder somewhere on your computer where you will save all media, including your downloaded music files.
2. Start with a visit to Jamendo (<http://jamendo.com>). Set up an account (it only takes a minute). Add a search term (e.g., podcast) and click on the **OK** button.



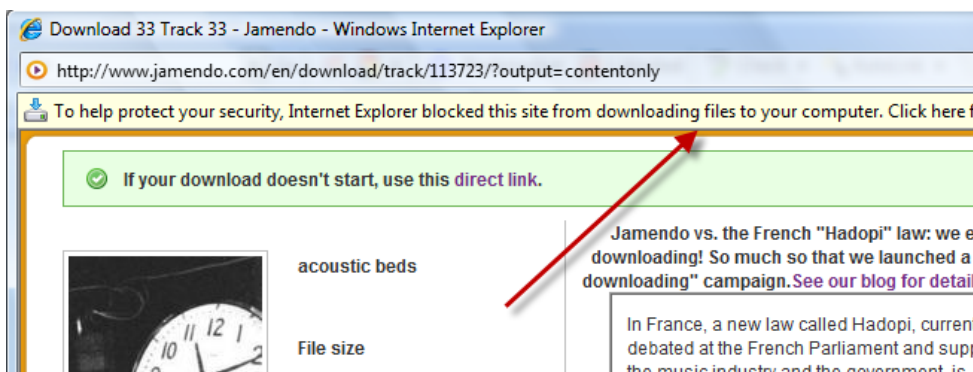
3. To open an album and view all the tracks, click on the title.



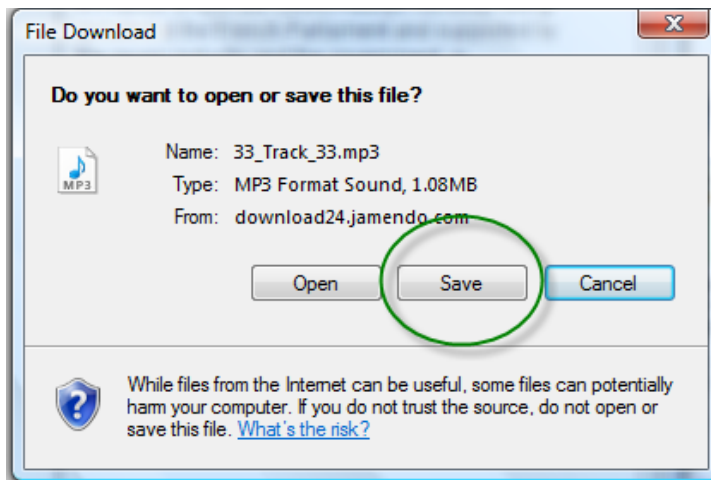
4. When you find a track you'd like to use in your podcast, click the download arrow.



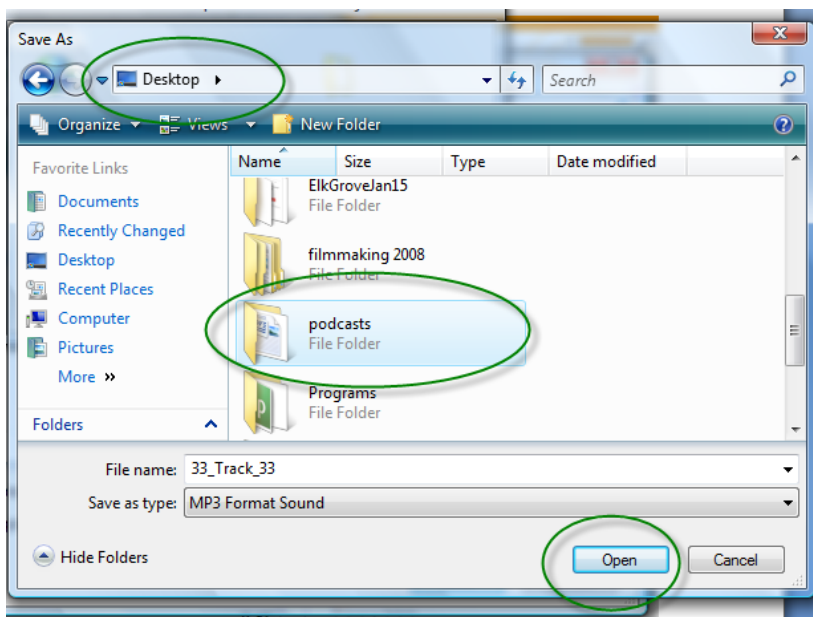
5. In order for your track to download, you may need to click on message at the top of the screen to allow the download.



6. When the File Download box opens, click on **Save**.



7. Before you click on the *Save* button, navigate to wherever you are saving your project media, select the folder, and click on the *Open* button. In the sample below, I've created a folder on my desktop called *podcasts*.



8. That's it. You should see the Download Complete box. Close the box and head into *Audacity*. You're ready to import your music track into your podcast!
